## **REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES**

**CALL TO ORDER/ ROLL CALL:** Chair Mikel Shilling called the Regular Board Meeting to order at 0900 hours. Members of the Board present included: Chair Mrs. Mikel Shilling, Board Clerk Mr. Bruce Howell, Mr. Harry Smith and Mr. Bill Katzel. See attached sign-in sheets for Green Valley Fire District staff, Green Valley Fire Corps, and members of the public present.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Mr. Katzel led members of the public, the staff, and the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC: None.

#### **CLERK'S REPORT: Clerk, Bruce Howell**

- **A. Approval of Minutes** Mr. Howell presented the minutes for the Regular Meeting of August 26, 2015. He then asked for any omissions, corrections, or additions. Mr. Katzel made a motion to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes and was seconded by Mr. Smith. There was no discussion, and the minutes were approved (4-0).
- **B.** Local Pension Board Update None.

# **CHIEF'S REPORT: Fire Chief Chuck Wunder**

- 1. Employee/Community Recognition Chief Wunder expressed his gratitude for a very successful Chili Cook-off, which raised over \$3500 for the Adopt-A-Family program. He also recognized FF Amy Helland for her coordination of the event. He then mentioned there was a Facebook post, on the Residents of Rancho page, that commended a few of our firefighters for outstanding customer service.
- **2. Legislative Issues** Chief Wunder stated that AFDA is working on its legislative agenda, and the major topics are on cap-related issues and pension reform.
- **3. GVFFA Meet & Confer Update** Chief Wunder stated that we will be completing a review of all of our policies during the remainder of the fiscal year. The E-Board,

Brenda, and Michelle will be reviewing all of the policies and making recommendations for changes or additions.

- **4. Administrative Update** Chief Wunder stated that there will be some job responsibilities changed around in Admin. Kay will be filling a role that will be more supportive to DC Kosiorowski, and Erica will be moving to the front desk to familiarize herself with more of the District's customer service needs.
- **5. Chiefs Committee** Chief Wunder stated that the Committee had its first meeting last month, and there was a lot of participation, for which he was pleased. The next meeting will be October 14, 2015.
- **6. Valley Emergency Communication Center (VECC) Update** Chief Wunder stated that with the help of Chief Chappel, the VECC board will start to review the current IGA for any updates.
- **7. Management Update** Chief Wunder stated that he attended a Pima Fire Chief's meeting in Tucson, and it was mentioned that there will be a lot of hiring occurring in in Pima County over the next six months. Chief then mentioned that he would be attending a meeting this evening regarding an annexation attempt in Elephant Head.
- **8. Financial Update** Mr. Gabe Buldra presented the August Financials Revenue was \$29,966 (\$66,472 under budget), and Non-Tax Revenue was \$93,733 (\$40,382 over budget). The District Expenses were \$633,429, (\$231,059 under budget). The report is on file.

A motion was made by Mr. Howell to accept the Financials as presented and seconded by Mr. Smith. There was no discussion, and the Financial Report was approved (4-0).

## **OPERATIONS REPORT: Division Chief Joey Kosiorowski.**

- **1. Fractiles/Response Data** DC Kosiorowski noted that District responses stand at 95% within 8 minutes or less, with a total of 276 non-emergency medical and 145 emergencies, for a total of 418 medical, on a total call volume of 903 calls. Engine 151 had the most calls of 186 (report on file).
- 2. Training and Communications DC Kosiorowski gave a PowerPoint presentation, which touched upon the following: (i) A Few Vehicle Collisions, (ii) A Vehicle vs. Tree, (iii) Local Fire Departments TRT Training with EMILY, (iv) Our Firefighters Attending AZ State Fire School, (v) Teaching Kids Fire Safety, (vi) Climb 4 the Fallen 2015, and (vii) The Association Chili Cook-off
- **3.** "I am GVFD" DC Kosiorowski introduced Firefighter Thomas Beckel, this month's "I Am GVFD," who then provided the Board with an overview of his history with the Green Valley Fire District.
