

Types of Extinguishers:

- Class A – Fires involve paper, wood, and other ordinary combustibles
- Class B—Fires involve flammable liquids, (ie. Oil, paints, gasoline)
- Class C—Fires involve energized electrical equipment



Home Fire Extinguishers

PORTABLE FIRE EXTINGUISHERS CAN SAVE LIVES AND PROPERTY BY CONTAINING OR PUTTING OUT SMALL FIRES.



When Fighting small fires: Be sure that...

- * Everyone is safe and someone is calling the fire department.
- * The fire is small, confined and not spreading.
- * You have an unobstructed escape route.
- * Your extinguisher matches the type of fire.
- * Keep your back to a clear exit and stand six to eight feet away from the flame.

To Operate your extinguisher, remember the acronym PASS

**P
A
S
S**

⇒ Pull the Pin that unlocks the lever.

1 Pull
the pin



⇒ Aim low, at the base of the fire.

2 Aim
at the base
of the fire



⇒ Squeeze the lever above the handle.

3 Squeeze
the handle



⇒ Sweep the nozzle or hose from side to side.

4 Sweep
from side
to side
