Maximum Class Size: 8 Students per Instructor.

Equipment may only be used by Certified Instructors per GVFD BLS TC Agreement (see separate fee schedule).

Cards will only be approved and issued by the TCC under AHA Standards and GVFD BLS TC criteria. Replacement cards are \$5 each.

All Instructors needing credit, equipment or cards from the TC must have classes preapproved and scheduled through the TC Coordinator, Battalion Chief William Rowe.

A 20% discount is offered on course fees for any organization needing certifications for more than **20 people. (To be issued within a 2-month period.)**

Prerequisite: All Instructor class candidates must have a BLS Provider update within 3 months of the class date, as well as a certificate showing completion of the 2015 BLS Instructor Essentials course, which may be found at: onlineaha.org. The Instructor Essentials course requires purchase through an approved AHA materials site, and the cost is \$30.

Fees are subject to change.
