FIREFIGHTER/EMT HIRING PROCESS

The Green Valley Fire District is currently accepting applications to fill open Firefighter/Emergency Medical Technician positions. The District serves approximately 45 square miles, responding to more than 10,000 calls for service annually. Firefighters respond to calls for assistance from our four fire stations, which are strategically located throughout the area. Our firefighters are divided into 3 platoons, working a 3-on/4-off shift schedule.

POSITION SUMMARY

The Firefighter/EMT responds to alarms and protects life and property by performing firefighting, emergency medicine, hazard control and other duties as assigned. Maintains fire and emergency medical equipment, apparatus, and facilities. Teamwork, service and respect for diversity are priorities when working for the Green Valley Fire District. This employee directly reports to and is supervised by the Fire Captain, but is also required to provide support to other District Captains and Chiefs, without direct supervision, to carry out routine tasks and assignments. Teamwork, service, and respect for diversity are priorities for all employees working for the Green Valley Fire District.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS must be submitted to Human Resources at least thirty days before the start of the Academy:

- **Twenty-one (21) years of age**
- **High school diploma or G.E.D. equivalent**
- **Valid and Unrestricted Driver's License must obtain Arizona License within six months of date of hire**
- **Arizona Firefighter I and II certification or NFPA 1001 equivalent**
- **Hazardous Materials First Responder – Operations Level**
- **Basic Wildland Firefighter**
- **Arizona Emergency Medical Technician or National Registry Emergency Medical Technician**
- **Current Healthcare Provider CPR**
- **Ability to speak, read, and write the English language**
- **Ability to meet GVFD physical standards for Suppression personnel**
- **Ability to meet insurability requirements of the District's insurance carrier**

SALARY RANGE - \$41,597 - \$55,097

EXAMINATION PROCESS - The competitive process will include application review, written test, physical ability test, oral board, and Chief's interview. Five preference points given for veterans and/or six (6) month of active membership with the GVFD Fire Corps.
