Free CERT Training

The spring session of Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training will be offered in two phases:

Phase I: Online training to be conducted individually at the student's own pace covering the topics shown on the left. Approximately 12 hours to complete during the period March 14 to April 8.

Phase II: With the supervision of a trained coach, demonstrate knowledge gained and skills learned during Phase I. This practical phase will be four classroom afternoon sessions, April 13, 14, 20 and 21 from 1:00 – 5:00 p.m. The culmination will be a disaster simulation exercise April 23, 9:00 – 11:30 a.m. To graduate students must attend each session.



After completing training, there is no obligation to join CERT or to respond to a community emergency. Those who do join will receive a CERT Kit and shirt.

This free CERT training will increase your ability and confidence to safely help yourself, your family, and neighbors. The CERT course will benefit anyone who takes it.

The Phase II sessions will be held at the Green Valley Fire District Training Center at 1285 W Camino Encanto.
